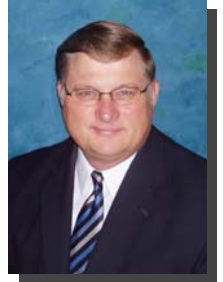
A Word From The Pastor - Dr. James W. Baker

We were visited by two missionaries in July. The **Brian Horner Family** was with us on Sunday, July 17th. **Bro. Hornor** presented his vision for their work in Mexico. Pray for them as they raise their support. Our church auditor and missionary, **Dr. Bob Vallier** was with us for a week. Bob takes care of the official audit of the financial books.

The last weeks of our mission year are exciting. We know the yearly promises of support for our missionaries are already met. The question is how much will we have for special projects. Missionaries all around the world are building and expanding their ministries in hard economic times. As we met the goal and exceeded it, we now know there is extra money to send to the field.
